



VEHICLE PREPARATION

GENERAL

- 1. Park snowmobile on a flat surface.
- 2. Push the engine stop switch down to the OFF position.
- 3. Turn the key to the OFF position and remove key.


ACCESSORY INSTALLATION

HANDGUARD / MOUNT ASSEMBLY

1. Install RH handguard ① onto RH mounting arm ⑤ using two of the provided screws 9. DO NOT overtighten.

TORQUE

Handguard Fasteners: **Tighten Until Fully Seated**




2. Repeat step 1 for opposite side.

HANDGUARD INSTALLATION


1. Place LH handguard assembly into position as shown. Loosely install the LH mounting cap (8) using supplied fasteners 10.

IMPORTANT


Be sure that you DO NOT pinch any electrical wires or brake line between the mounts themselves and/or handlebars when installing.



2. Carefully rotate the handguard assembly upward and into position.



3. Verify that the handguard assembly does not interfere with the brake mechanism. Make sure that the parking brake locking mechanism is free to rotate into the fully locked position and does not make contact with the upper mount or any other portion of the handguard assembly.



WARNING

You MUST VERIFY brake mechanism has full brake and parking brake functions after installation of handguards and BEFORE starting engine. Adjust handguards if necessary to avoid any interference with brake function.

Failure to comply could result in death or serious personal injury.

4. Once in the proper position, torque mounting fasteners (10) to specification.




5. Place RH handguard assembly into position as shown. Loosely install the RH mounting cap 6 using supplied fasteners 10.



6. Carefully rotate the handguard assembly upward and into position.



7. Once again, be sure to verify there are no pinched electrical wires and/or cables.


